Course Background

Morbidity and mortality is very high among infants and pre-school children. Under Five Mortality in India is a major concern. Most of the sick infants and children are seeking services outside the tertiary care centers where qualified pediatric specialists are not available. In most of the secondary levels institutions (CHC/ Sub-District and District Hospitals), pediatric services are not uniformly available. Medical and paramedical professionals of different levels are managing the pediatric emergencies. Government of India has also made several training initiatives in this domain. However, scope for building capacities on emergency pediatric conditions is very high.

Stanford and GVK EMRI have jointly developed District Hospital Physician Training (DHPT) course to building capacities among doctors working in district and sub-district hospitals and other low-resource settings. Pediatric component of DHPT was identified as a training need and a special 2-day pediatric module is now developed by Stanford.

Course Description

This clinical paediatric course is designed to provide students with the knowledge, skills, and abilities to promote excellence in emergency care of ill and injured children through the provision of high quality teaching and training methods applied to ensure skills acquisition. The manual for DHPT participants is specially developed to meet the case management as per the current evidences and suitable to low-resource settings.

Course contents

1. Recognition of critically ill children
2. Basic and advanced airway management
3. Circulation – IV fluids
4. IV access and pressers
5. Resuscitation room
6. Code card
7. Broselow chart
8. Sepsis
9. Dehydration
10. Fever
11. Respiratory emergencies
12. Seizures
13. Anaphylaxis
14. Trauma etc.
